

Tribal Monitor - Long Canyon Mine

Job Description: The Tribal Monitor will participate and obtain firsthand knowledge of archaeological excavations and construction in areas that are known to have cultural sensitivity or have the potential for cultural deposit. The Tribal Monitor is an employee of WCRM that may also report to their Tribal Government.

Role: Tribal Monitors have no supervisory responsibilities. This position reports directly to a Crew Chief or Field Supervisor when monitoring.

Tribal Monitor Competencies: Previous experience in monitoring preferred but not necessary. May require overnight travel for upwards of a 10-day time period. Must be able to undertake a moderate to high level of physical activity. Must have a tolerance for working in outdoor environments, prolonged walking or standing on various terrain in a wide range of weather conditions. Valid driver's license preferred but not necessary.

Minimum Qualifications:

Education: No specific educational requirements.

Certification: MSHA 24-hour New Miner Certification. Preference will be given to monitors who currently hold valid MSHA certifications.

Experience: Previous experience in monitoring is preferred but is not necessary. Demonstrated experience with basic field application of archaeological principles is preferred. Demonstrated experience with federal, state, local and tribal legislation pertaining to cultural resources preferred.
Additional Requirements:

Ethics: Tribal Monitors are required to adopt and sign the BLM Code of Ethics and Conduct.
Duties: Monitor all ground disturbing activity including mass grading, grubbing, weed abatement, trenching and any excavation on previously disturbed and undisturbed ground. Ability to recognize cultural artifacts, sites and features. Take digital photos and prepare photo logs. Prepare daily field monitoring logs and other materials, including information of a confidential nature. Attend/participate in job-related conferences and trainings resulting in some travel and overnight stays
